Prepaid Benefit Card - How it works

- Payroll deductions are taken one month prior to availability
- Card cannot be swiped for more than monthly IRS maximums
- Correct home zip code required for verification at certain locations

- Prepaid Benefit card is mailed to home
- If you already have a Prepaid Benefit card the funds will reload
- If card doesn't work, you can submit a claim (**PARKING ONLY**)
- Reimbursements are processed and issued weekly

Keep In Mind

Manual reimbursements will no longer be accepted for the Transportation account.
Use of the Prepaid Benefit card will be the only option available.
